Next Term's School Fees: The School Office will be open until the 9th of July (9.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. Monday to Thursday and 9.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on Fridays), and again from August 23rd for enquiries, the receipt of outstanding fees and next term's school fees. The following payment arrangements will apply next term:

- Fees for the term are due on the first day of term
- Fees can be paid by cheque or by depositing cash in our bank account and presenting the deposit slip
- Fees should not be paid in cash at the school
- Fees can be paid in three monthly instalments
- Instalments are due on the 1st day of term, the 1st of October and the 1st of November. Timely payment by instalments will be required from parents wishing to pay by this method
- Children whose fees are still outstanding from this term will not be accepted back at the beginning of next term
- End of term reports and leaving transcripts will not be issued until all fees have been paid
- A fees invoice with full payment details will be issued with end of term report

Term starts for children on Wednesday, August 25th
